The Thompson Valley Art League presents the 2010 June Juried Fine Arts Show from June 29 through July 30, 2010. The show is held at the Lincoln Gallery, 429 N. Lincoln Avenue in Loveland, Colorado. Contact Jeff Brooks at 970-663-2407 for information.

Eligibility;

Open to any artist working in listed categories. Works must be completed original art, not copied from published photos or works by other artists. No installations or sets of works to make one entry. Entries must be in good taste and have not received a cash award from any previous Art League sponsored shows.

Categories;

1. Oil Painting: oil paint and water-soluble oil paint.
 2. Water media: gouache, tempera, casein or watercolor.
 3. Mixed Media: pencil, charcoal, pen/ink, colored pencil, collage, mono-prints or combinations of media.
 4. Photography: Recording an object with an image-forming device. Image may be manipulated by emulsion or a digital means from artists original mage. Computer graphic work not accepted.
 5. Three dimensional: includes Bas Relief
 6. Acrylic: Acrylic polymer based emulsion or paint
 7. Pastel: chalk or oil based
- Artwork not meeting any above criteria shall be rejected.

Entries;

Only walk in entries of original artworks will be accepted for juroring. Works are accepted at Lincoln Gallery starting June 22, 11 am to 5 pm, through Saturday June 26, at 1 pm.

Artists may submit up to three entries for a fee of \$12 per entry. Entry fee is non refundable.

Artists will be notified by phone of **unaccepted** pieces to be picked up the afternoon of June 26th. Only works selected by the juror will be displayed and eligible for awards from the show. **Unaccepted works** must be removed from the gallery by Tuesday June 29. A storage fee of \$3 per day will be charged until unaccepted works are removed.

Details;

Flat work (including frame) **shall not exceed (36) inches** on any one side and be wired to hang. Works exceeding these dimensions, wet or with Saw-tooth hangers will not be accepted. Entry fee non-refundable.

Gallery wrapped paintings are acceptable as long as all sides are painted and no staples are visible. It is recommended that "gallery wrapped style canvas" be secured on 1 1/2" thick stretcher bars. Flat work to be hung cannot weigh more than 25 lbs. Attach label to the back upper right corner of work.

Three-dimensional works must be completed works, no more than 46 inches in any one dimension weighing no more than 90 pounds. Artists may be required to provide a display stand. Relief works are considered 3-D & must be wired for hanging. Works must be marked by labels from entry form.

Submitting entries for this show hereby gives TVAL permission for reproducing artworks for advertising and promotional means.

Sales;

All works must be for sale and remain on display until closing of exhibit. Sales will be encouraged to further the efforts of the Artists and to stimulate acquisition of original art by patrons and the public. A 35% commission will be charged by TVAL on all sales. Payment of sold items will be made within two weeks after closing of the show.

Awards;

A "Juror's Choice Award" will be presented to one artist from the show. Ribbons awarded for first, second and third place in each category. Additional category prizes include cash and gift certificates supported by local entities.

"Effie L. Brooks" memorial award for a Colorado Landscape. Must be a **Colorado scene** supported by title or a location within the State. To be completed from an Oil, Watercolor or Pastel medium, see category criteria.

Juror will select works to be displayed. No preview of works or access during this process.

Artists will be notified by phone to pick up **unaccepted entries** between 3-5 pm Saturday June 26. Provide a phone number on entry form where we can reach you that afternoon. Efforts will be made to have selections completed and contacts made by 5 pm.

If prior arrangements are not made a storage fee of \$3.00 per day will be charged for artwork left after the juroring process and closing of the show. Contact Lincoln Gallery for pickup arrangements.

Shipping: Contact Shippers Supply in Loveland, CO, 970-663-2330 for information to ship artwork. Artists are responsible for shipping charges. There is a \$25.00 handling fee for shipment of artwork by TVAL.

Juror of Awards: Robert Spooner

Robert states that his art is not about any one approach but is more about pushing and experimenting with various elements and techniques. The discoveries he makes along the way are what enable him to grow as a painter and fuel his desire to become a better artist.

Robert Spooner was born in Roswell, New Mexico in 1956. He received a bachelor of fine arts degree from Louisiana Tech University in 1978 and pursued a career in graphic design. It was not until 1998 that he developed an interest in oil painting after having taken it up as a creative antidote to the structured advertising world where he was working as a designer and illustrator. He became further motivated to continue on this path of expression when he enrolled in painting classes at the Denver Art Students League and studied with noted painters Kim English and Quang Ho.
