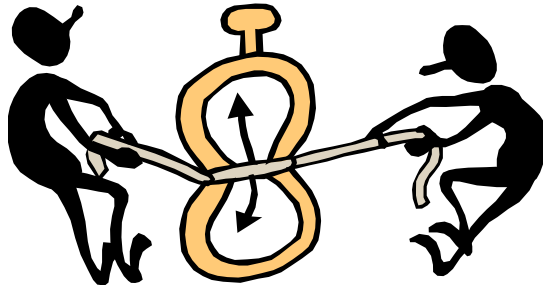

## Sweet-Art Show

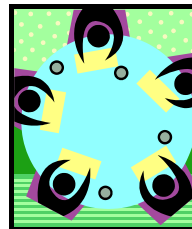
