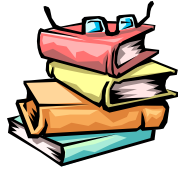

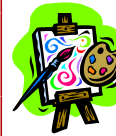


# A in the PARK

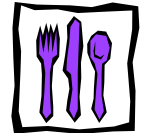
### Plein Air/Pot Luck Picnic!

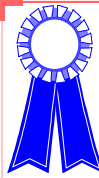

### Plea From The President

This month I want to talk about fund raising. I know you're thinking, "I'm not reading this", or "it sounds like the preacher to me". But let's think about it a bit, fund raising gives a BIG boost to the operation of our business, which can only help your pocket. These funds help to pay for costs that TVAL accrues during a normal year of operations. We as members enjoy lots of benefits. We have a low membership fees, opportunities for classes, and a director who allows us to spend more time on our art instead of sitting the gallery several hours a month. We have the opportunity to find a few friends to share our art experiences with and improve our skills. Plus, we have outlets to sell your goods at a low commission. What a deal for \$65.00 a year! But in order to stay in the black and still enjoy these great benefits we must ask you for help with funding. So ask the plumber, the candle stick maker and the cafe owner, or anyone who might benefit from some advertising. Besides the advertising, the business owner will also get a tax deduction when they advertise with us because we are a nonprofit 501-3-c. That's a great benefit to them. Last summer I campaigned different businesses for Art in the Park and was flabbergasted at the number of businesses that were waiting for the opportunity to give so that they could do some VERY inexpensive advertising. The only cost they have is the cost of their coupon or advertisement. Again, I was surprised at how many people stopped to pickup the business coupons that we placed in the park.
