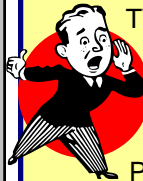

Entry fee is \$10 per entry with a limit of 3 entries per person. Ribbons will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for each category. A "Jurors Choice", Memorial "Colorado Landscape" and any other awards supported by local entities will be cash or Gift certificates. Only walk-in entries will be accepted beginning June 1st through June 5th, 11-5pm and on June 6th, 10-1pm. **Our juror** will be professional artist and teacher, **Mark Silvers**. An award winning watercolorist, he is admired for his depiction of light, luminous color and composition. He has been featured in the National Watercolor Society, Watercolor USA and Allied Artists of America in New York City among others. He has won numerous awards and is a popular instructor at Colorado State University, Loveland Academy of Fine Arts, the Denver Museum as well as private classes and workshops in several states. 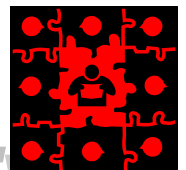
