Expectations:

- Participate in 3 Night on the Town (NOTT) Events (2nd Friday of each month; be present for at least 2 hours; NOTT including Regional and National Fine Art opening reception)
- Actively create new work
- Participate in one committee
- Volunteer at Art in the Park
- Gallery sit when needed

Self-Promotion

- Must have an up-to-date website
- Like/follow gallery's social media page

- Send invitation to friends and family for major events held at the gallery

Along with the electronic application bring in hard copies of application, artist bio, and art priced and ready to be hung.

For 3D Artists:

This application must include the following:

(Send electronic information via email to lincolngallery@lincolngallery.com - please include 'Membership Application' in the subject of your email)

- The artist's bio
- The artist's website address
- JPEG files of at least 4 representative pieces of your art

Along with the electronic application bring in hard copies of application, artist bio, and art priced and ready to be displayed.

Members may show in the gallery for 40 weeks out of the year. The Lincoln Gallery hosts the National Fine Art Show and the Regional Fine Art Show when we open our doors to outside artists. Members are highly encouraged to apply and receive 33% off on the submission fees. See the Chair of the Committee for details *

Types of Membership

Sustaining Members (\$500):

- Sustaining Hanging Members may display up to four pieces; sizes determined by the director of the gallery
- Sustaining Members have the opportunity to display on a monthly basis each medium for which they have been accepted.
- Sustaining Members retain voting and displaying privileges as long as the membership level requirements are upheld.
- Sustaining Members will have a short bio on the website, up to 5 images of their artwork and a link to their website.
- Sustaining Members will be promoted via social media
- Sustaining Members' will have the opportunity to become the **featured artist of the month** (according to the organizations *Featured Artist Guidelines and Requirements*) which includes a live demonstration during Night on the Town, twice as much "wall space" to display art, prime gallery wall space, write up on website, twice as much social media exposure, NOTT promotion, and ability to sell
- Each Sustaining member is required to volunteer at Art in the Park, as determined by the event director.
- Each Sustaining Member is required to attend November (voting) membership meetings

Exhibiting Members (\$400):

- Exhibiting Members may display up to two pieces; sizes determined by the director of the gallery
- Exhibiting Members have the opportunity to display on a monthly basis each medium for which they have been accepted.
- Exhibiting Members retain voting and displaying privileges as long as the membership level requirements are upheld.
- Exhibiting Members will have a short bio on the website, up to 5 images of their artwork and a link to their website.
- Each Exhibiting Member is required to volunteer at Art in the Park, as determined by the event director.
- Each Exhibiting Member is required to attend November (voting) membership meetings

Active Members (\$200 2018 Members; \$240 New Members):

- Active Hanging members may display up to two pieces; sizes determined by the director of the gallery.
- Active 3D members may display art in an appropriate display for their medium in the space and display as agreed to with the directors of the gallery.
- Active Members have the opportunity to display on a monthly basis each medium for which they have been accepted.
- Active Members retain voting and displaying privileges as long as the membership level requirements are upheld.
- Active Members will have a short bio on the website up to 5 images of their artwork and a link to their website.
- Each Active member is required to volunteer at Art in the Park, as determined by the event director.
- Each Active member is required to attend November (voting) membership meetings
- Each Active member is required to attend three membership meetings per year
- Each Active member is required to serve on one committee
- Each Active member is required to participate in 3 Night on the Town from 5:30-8:30 pm (NOTT- held on the second Friday of each month)
- Each Active member is required to attend the opening night of the Regional and National Fine Art Show

Aspiring Artist (3 Months Maximum in Duration \$50)

- Must be invited by the Director of the Gallery
- Aspiring Artists have the opportunity to display on a monthly basis each medium for which they have been accepted.
- Aspiring Artists will assist in social media
- Aspiring Artists will be promoted via social media
- Aspiring Artists will have the opportunity to become the featured artist of the month; which includes a live demonstration during Night on the Town, twice as much "wall space" to display art, prime gallery wall space, write up on website, twice as much social media exposure, NOTT promotion, and ability to sell small pieces during demonstration.

Art Enthusiast (\$50):

- Patron membership is non-voting, non-showing member who wishes to support of the organization through:
 - Volunteer time
 - In-kind services
 - Receiving a 5% discount on art classes; Discount on workshops and classes.
 - Monetary donations. Monetary donations can be paid as a lump sum or quarterly and qualify as a tax deduction as allowed by IRS regulations.

All memberships shall be due and payable January 1 of each calendar year. If dues are not paid by January 31 of each new year, membership and privileges will be terminated. Reconsideration of membership will be as per the Policies and Guidelines. Yearly membership dues are non-refundable.
