The first hour of the reception will be reserved for photographers and their guests. The announcement of awards will be live on Facebook at 6:30. The public portion of the reception will begin at 7 pm.

The north half of the Gallery will be devoted to the show, with the south half of the Gallery and the gift shop filled with our members' artworks.

Members Meeting: November 18, 6:30 pm
