MATERIALS LIST

November 13 & 14, 2022

9:00 am to 4:00 pm for two days

Linda will provide:

- paraffin wax
- pots to melt wax in
- brushes to use in the wax
- specialty cloud unryu paper
- archival pen
- clean newsprint

Participants will need to bring:

- watercolor paint (artists' quality paint yields the best results)
- palette
- watercolor brushes
- water containers
- photos you would like to evaluate for future batiks (Linda will consult with you)
- miscellaneous items you like to have on hand (paper towels, apron, notebook, etc)

Items to bring to share:

- newspapers! We will need a lot of these as we iron out the wax.
- irons. Linda will bring hers – we will need more so several people can work at once.

All participants will paint the same painting in order to make it possible to complete the project in two days. Linda will have the initial step(s) completed in order to “jump-start” the process.

Workshop students do need to have some experience in watercolor.
