This workshop guides participants through a journey of discovery and exploration to unveil and develop their unique artistic voice. Through a series of interactive activities, discussions, and time at the easel (or table!), participants will gain insights into their personal artistic style, preferences, and expressions.

About the workshop...

Day 1 – Explore all the facets of *Artistic Voice* with presentation, interactions, and working exercises.

Day 2 – Start the day off with Jamie demonstrating at the easel how to take Day 1's results and apply them to your work. Attendees then work on the project of their own choice (as revealed on Day 1) with guidance.

Day 3 – A full day of working on your project with a final recap and closing to take this process home with you to continue in your studio practice.

Jamie Lindholm has been painting professionally for more than three decades. Before moving to Colorado, she owned and operated The Martinsville Studio where she taught Foundational Studies in Drawing and Painting to students of all ages along with weekly painting workshops for adults. In her years there,

she taught more than eight hundred students. She is a Signature member of American Women

Artists, has won numerous awards, and has her work in public and private collections in Sweden, Australia, Switzerland, and North America. In 2018, after decades of honing her technical skills, she yearned to explore and find her own voice. She went back to school for her MFA and concentrated on expression. It was pivotal in changing her work to what is seen today.
