Linda will provide:


- o paraffin wax

- brushes to use in the wax
- specialty cloud unryu paper
- o archival pen
- o clean newsprint

Participants will need to bring:

- watercolor paint (artists' quality paint yields the best results)
- o palette
- watercolor brushes
- water containers
- photos you would like to evaluate for future batiks
 (Linda will consult with you)
- miscellaneous items you like to have on hand (paper towels, apron, notebook, etc)
- magnifying glass if you have trouble seeing small shapes
- o drawing board at least 14" x 16." If you have masking tape and freezer paper, bring that also. Linda will bring a couple extra drawing boards that she has.
- o light box if you have one!

Items to bring to share:

- o newspapers! We will need a lot of these as we iron out the wax.
- o irons. Linda will bring hers we will need more so several people can work at once.
- o hair dryers.
