Brighten your week with sunflowers! Learning the process of wax batik yields lessons that apply across all painting and drawing media.

The process of watercolor wax batik will be explained, demonstrated and practiced in this hands-on, intensive workshop. Learn how to select the best photos to work from, plan your painting, build the multiple layers of wax and watercolor and then do the final batiking and the “reveal.”

Topics covered will include:

- Recognizing value changes (light to dark)
- Review of color – color harmonies, analogous & complementary colors
- Planning your painting; first wax application – and initial wash of watercolor
- Continuing with the planning/diagramming process
 - Building up the layers
 - Batiking your painting
 - The “reveal” – removing the wax, sharing the results
