The Opening Reception for the National Fine Art Show will be *this Friday, May 11 from 6-9pm* in conjunction with the downtown Loveland 'Night on the Town' event.

Awards for the show will be presented at 6:30 followed by our **opening gala** featuring entertainment, refreshments and the opportunity to meet the artists in the show.

We had 153 artists apply for the show with 503 entries! We received entries from 28 states!

The show will feature 85+ invited artwork pieces.

This will be one of our main events for the year, so come and join the fun and see the excellent art in our 2018 National Fine Art Show.
